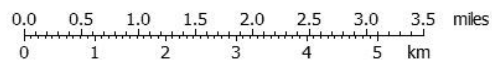
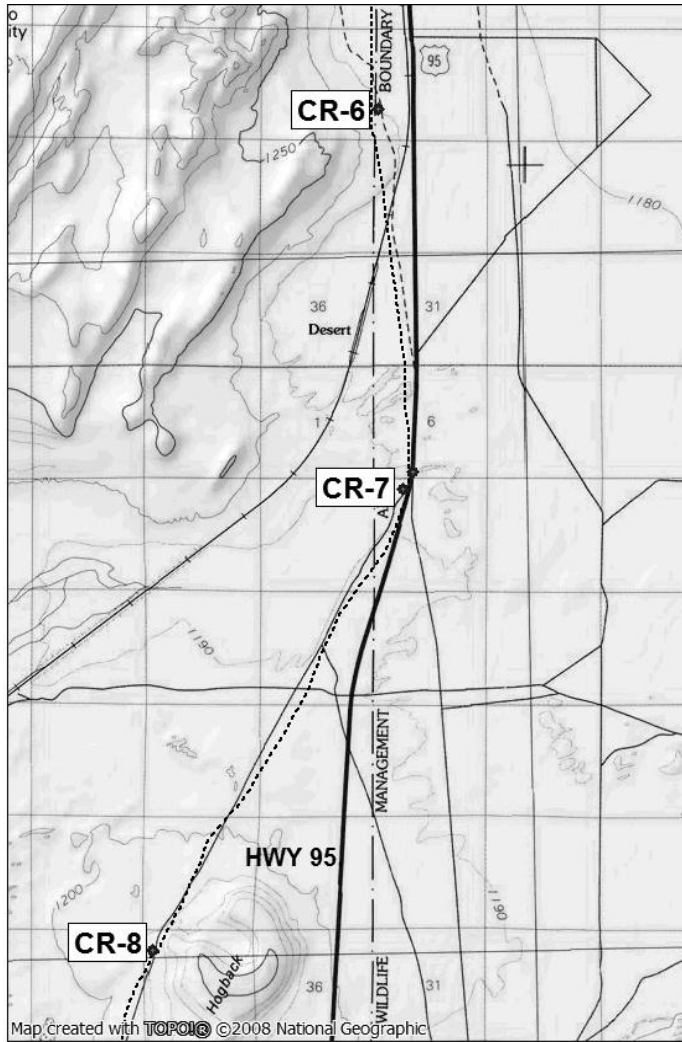

ALONG THIS NOTORIOUS ROUTE, REMINDING ONE OF THE DEFEAT OF SOME
GREAT ARMY." -JOHN HAWKINS CLARK, AUG 18, 1852

How to Find:

From Marker CR-6, return to Highway 95.

Turn right. Go 7.8 miles to a gravel stockpile area and a dirt road on the right.

Turn right. Go 100 yards, bearing left of the pond of water, to the marker.

The marker is located on a used section of the trail.
