

MARKER CR-13

CARSON TRAIL-JUNCTION WAGON & PACK ROUTES

"WE CONTINUED ON FOLLOWING THE RIVER, THE MAIN ROAD LEAVING THE RIVER FOR 12 MILES, OVER A STRIP OF DESERT WITHOUT GRASS OR WATER THE ROAD ALONG THE RIVER BEING A PACK ROUTE AND IMPRACTICAL FOR WAGONS" -CALVIN TAYLOR, SEP 17, 1850

How To Find:

From Marker CR-12, continue 3.8 miles, first on a paved road and then on a gravel road, to a road junction.

Pioneer Way is the approximate route of the original Carson Trail.

Turn right. Go 25 yards north, crossing over a canal, to the marker on the left.

The marker is just past the canal bridge and next to a power pole on the left side of the road.
