

Updates to “A Guide To The California Trail Along The Humboldt River”

(5th Edition)

Page 56 – HOW TO FIND: Change the driving information in the How To Find box to:

Go 3.4 miles (south) on Beowawe-Crescent Hwy (Hwy 306) to a metal gate on the left (permission to enter required).

(Note, this should only be attempted with 4WD.) Enter and continue straight ahead on a dirt road for 0.6 mile to the 1st road to the left.

Turn left (north) and go 0.3 mile crossing the creek to the first road on the right.

Turn right (east) and go 1.0 mile to the 1st “Y” road junction. Stay right following Long Draw.

Go 4.5 miles to the 2nd “Y” road junction. Stay left.

Go 1.6 miles, first ascending to a saddle and then descending to Emigrant Creek Canyon. There turn left (north).

Go up the canyon a short distance to the marker, about 100 yards past a cattle water trough.

Page 57 – Change the 2nd paragraph to: HOW TO FIND: From Marker C-43, return 1.6 miles to the 2nd “Y” road junction. Turn left onto a bladed road.
