

Updates to “A Guide To The California Trail Along The Humboldt River” (3rd Edition)

Page 27 – Marker C-36. There have been Warning and Private Property signs erected on and near a gate on the road into C-36. This road is BLM and following the How-To-Find driving instructions to the marker will keep you legally on public land.

Page 85 – Map 9. Change the reference to Map 18 in the insert box in the lower right corner of the map to “**Map 8**”

Page 172 -- Change the coordinates for C-36 to:
N 40 56.910, W 115 37.634

Page 121 – HOW TO FIND: Follow the existing instructions in the How-To-Find box to the end of the second paragraph. The marker was shifted 115 yards to the left (southwest) to be on the original Southside Trail. Walk that 115 yards to the new marker location; do not drive to it. New research has determined the original trail heads southwest (across the railroad) toward newly located Marker C-65A. The previous marker location was on a later wagon road heading more westerly from historic Mill City to intersect the original Southside Trail.

Page 171 – Change the coordinates for C -65A to:
407330E, 4503092N

Page 173 – Change the coordinates for C-65A to:
N 40 40.518, W 118 05.847
