MARKER T-15

Page 52 – Replace the How To Find and coordinates with the following:

From Marker T-14, continue ahead to I-80 westbound. Go 5.0 miles west to EXIT 36-DERBY DAM.

Exit I-80 and go to the stop sign.

Turn left. Cross over the freeway.

Turn right. Go 1.3 miles on the paved (it turns to gravel after about one mile) frontage road to the marker on the right. Do not cross over the railroad tracks.

LAT/LONG: N39° 35.393', W 119° 27.217'

UTM: 11S 289301 E, 4385117 N

Make the above coordinate changes on pages 168 and 172.

MARKER T-16

Page 55 – Replace the How To Find and coordinates with the following:

From Marker T-15, return to I-80.

Go west on I-80 to EXIT 23 - MUSTANG.

Exit the freeway. Turn left on the frontage road.

Go 0.4 mile west to a sharp curve and a gate.

The gate is usually open Monday thru Friday, but may be closed at any time and at odd hours. It is probably a good idea to walk to the marker.

Continue through the gate. Go to a two track road immediately on the left just past the power lines.

Turn left. Go 150 yards up the hill to the marker on the left just past the second power pole.

LAT/LONG: N 39° 31.030', W 119° 38.069'

UTM: 11S 273529 E, 4377484 N

The coordinates will also need to be changed on pages 168 & 173.

MARKER T-17

Page 56 - Replace the How To Find with the following:

There is no public access to Marker T-17. For this reason, we have installed a reference marker with public access. This reference marker is located about 500 yards east of the true Marker T-17. The reference marker, which is the same as T-17, can be reached by walking through Lockwood Park on the County access trails.

From Marker T-16, return to I-80.

Turn right. Go 2.0 miles west to EXIT 22 - LOCKWOOD.

Exit I-80 and cross over the freeway. Follow the road to the second road on the right, just before the bridge, which is the entrance to Lockwood Park.

Turn right into the Park and follow the road to the parking area near the restrooms.

From there, follow the trail past the restroom to the marker at the west end of the park. The walk is less than a mile round trip on an easy graded trail. Any of the trails will get you there, just keep heading west.

MARKER T-18

Page 58 - Replace the How To Find and the coordinates with the following:

NOTE: THIS MARKER HAS LIMITED ACCESS.

From Marker 17, return to I-80. Go west to EXIT 19 - McCARRAN BLVD. EAST

Exit I-80 and turn left on McCarran Blvd.

Go 1.3 miles, passing Greg St. to Clean Water Way on the left.

Turn left. Go 1.8 miles to the gate and guardhouse at the sewage treatment plant.

If the guardhouse is manned, ask permission to access the marker. (It is located on the east side of the plant) If permission is granted, drive into the plant to the main office in the facility plant building and you will be given directions to the marker.

If the gate is locked or permission is not granted, there is no access to the marker.

MARKER T-19

Page 59 - Replace the How To Find with the following:

From the gate/guardhouse access to Marker T-18, you are at Marker T-19.

The marker is located on the northern edge of the turnaround area just to the left of the gate/guardhouse for the sewage treatment plant.

LAT/LONG: N 39°30.846', W 119°42.580'

UTM: 11S 267056 E, 4377336 N

MARKER T-44

Page 97 – This marker is in a new location with a new diary quote.

TRUCKEE TRAIL-A VERY HIGH, PROJECTING ROCKY MOUNTAIN [DEVILS PEAK]

“THE ROAD WAS ROUGHER...IMMENSE...ROCKS. ...UP & DOWN HILL; ONE IN PARTICULAR, ABOUT 5 MILES FROM STARTING, WAS SO STEEP AS TO HAVE TO LET OUR WAGONS DOWN BY ROPES...PASSED 6 LAKES...COMMENCED ASCENDING A ...MOUNTAIN...TWO MILES,...THIS PEAK [DEVILS PEAK]...IS REMARKABL FOR ITS...SHAPE” -WAKEMAN BRYARLY, AUG 23, 1849

How To Find:

From Marker T-43, continue straight ahead on Kidd Lake Road, passing Camp Wamp on the left at 0.6 mile, Kidd Lake Group Camp on the left at 0.8 mile, and the Kidd Lake outlet channel bridge at 1.3 miles, to the Devil’s Lookout Warming Hut at 1.8 miles.

At the warming hut, turn right on the road and pass close to the hut on your right.

Pass the hut and follow the road to a fork in the road.

Turn left at the fork and go downhill.

Continue to another fork in the road.

Turn left and continue downhill.

Continue about 0.3 mile to the end of the road at the Palisades Creek Trailhead.

The marker is on the left just past the beginning of the trail.

LAT/LONG: N 39°18.077’, W 120°26.124’

UTM: 10S 721143 E, 4353346 N
