Page 45 – Replace the How To Find with the following.

From Marker N-3, continue 5.4 miles on the bladed Jungo Road to a dirt road on the right. The marker is located on the right at the intersection.

LAT/LON: 40° 45.818'N 119° 07.457'W

UTM: 11T 320701E, 4514689N

The coordinates will also need to be changed on pages 195 & 196.


Page 47 - Replace the How To Find with the following.

From Marker N-4, turn right and go 2.9 miles crossing over the railroad tracks, out on to the playa to a junction with a dirt road. (The road you pass going to the right just before the railroad tracks goes 0.25 mile to the Trego Hot Springs where the emigrants camped.)

Turn left. Go 0.9 mile to the location where the sand mound and Marker N-5 can be seen off to the right about 400 yards away.

Turn right. Go 400 yards to the marker.

Page 49 – Replace the map on page 49 with the one below.

Page 100-N-29

In the How To Find—Replace the first two sentences with:

From Marker N-28, return to Highway 44.

Turn left. Go 5.2 miles to the gravel road on the right, FS Rd 31N06.

This road is also signed as 20BC Line

Page 101- N-30

In the How To Find, replace the first sentence with: "From Marker N-29, continue 1.9 miles north on the Bridge Creek Spring Road to a dirt road on the left signed 100 BC."

Page 108—N-32/L-32

In the How To Find, replace the third paragraph with:

Turn left. Go through the gate and close it. Go 0.5 mile on the main track to a road intersection and the marker on the right.

Page 112-N-34

In the How To Find, replace the second paragraph with:

Turn right. Go 3.9 miles to a yellow highway sign on the right.

Park near the sign. Walk back up the highway 50 yards to the marker located 30 Yards left (north) of the edge of the highway.

Page 131—N-45

Replace the How To Find with:

From Marker N-43, return to the black cinder surfaced road FS Rd 32N13 This road is also signed as HH Line

Turn left. Go 1.0 mile to a dirt road on the left, FS Rd 32N90.

This road is also signed as 30 HH.

Turn left. Go 1.5 miles, passing dirt roads to the right at 1.3 miles and 1.4 miles, to a dirt road on the right.

Refer to the map on Page 132

Turn right. Go 50 yards to the marker on the right on top of a dirt mound.

Page 133-N-46

In the How To Find, replace the 2<sup>nd</sup> paragraph with the following:

Turn left. Go 2.9 miles to the marker on the right in an old road/swale.

The marker is located 30 yards before FS Rd 31N92.

Page 134—N-44

Replace the How To Find with:

From Marker N-46, continue 3.1 miles on FS Rd 32N13 to Highway 44.

Turn right. Go 0.9 mile to a turnout on the right.

Turn into the turnout and park. Walk 33 yards up a dirt road at the east end of the turnout to the marker.

Page 136—N-47

In the How To Find, replace the existing info with the following:

From Marker N-44, return to Highway 44. Turn left. Go 0.9 mile to FS Rd 32N13 on the left.

Turn left. Go 0.5 mile to a dirt road, FS Rd 32N13F, on the right.

Turn right. Go 0.2 mile to the marker on the right.

The area near the marker would make a nice primitive campsite.

Page 138-N-48

In the How To Find, replace the first sentence with:

From Marker N-47, return to Highway 44.

#### Page 147-N-53

In the How To Find, replace the first sentence with:

From Marker N-52, continue west 0.9 mile on the Deer Flat Road to the paved Emigrant Trail Road on the right.

## Page 148-N-54

Replace the How To Find with:

From Marker N-53, continue to Highway 44.

Turn right. Go 2.4 miles to a road on the left, Squaw Springs Road.

Turn left. Go 0.2 mile to a Y intersection.

Turn right. Go 0.3 mile to a path on the right side of the road. Park near the path. Walk a short distance to the bridge over Millseat Creek and the marker on the left.

### Page 150-N-55

In the How To Find, in the 2<sup>nd</sup> paragraph, replace 2.1 miles with 2.4 miles.
